BYELAWS MADE UNDER SECTION 164 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACT 1875 BY THE FYLDE BOROUGH COUNCIL WITH RESPECT TO THE HOVE ROAD RECREATION GROUND

PLAYING OF GAMES

- Throughout these byelaws the expression "the Council" means the Fylde Borough Council and the expression "the pleasure ground" known as Hove Road Recreation Ground;
- A person who has attained the age of 14 years shall not on the pleasure ground play or take part in any ball games;

Provided that this byelaw shall not apply to any person who being bona fide in charge of a child under the age of 14 years plays or takes part in any ball game with that child.

3. Any person offending against the byelaw shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding one hundred pounds.
