



# Fylde Local Plan to 2032 Adoption Statement

*The Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004*

*The Town and Country Planning England (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012-Regulation 26*

*The Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulations 2004 – Regulation 16*

Notice is given that on 22 October 2018 Fylde Council adopted the Fylde Local Plan to 2032, a Development Plan Document.

## **Subject matter and area covered:**

The Fylde Local Plan to 2032 (the Local Plan) covers the whole of the Borough for the period 2011-2032. It provides the statutory planning framework for the Borough for non-minerals and waste matters. It replaces the Fylde Borough Local Plan As Altered 2005.

## **Examination:**

The Submission Version of the Fylde Local Plan to 2032 was submitted to the Secretary of State on the 9<sup>th</sup> December 2016. An independent inspector was appointed by the Secretary of State to conduct an Examination into the soundness and legal compliance of the Local Plan, including the Duty to Cooperate.

## **Modifications:**

The Inspector's Report, of the Examination was received on 19th September 2018. The Report concluded that the Local Plan is legally compliant and with specific main modifications, is sound.

The adopted Local Plan incorporates the main modifications recommended by the Inspector, together with additional (minor) modifications made by the Council which do not materially affect the policies in the Local Plan.

The full list of main modifications made to the Submitted Local Plan can be found as an Appendix to the Inspector's Report which has been published on the Council's website.

## **Challenge:**

Any person who is aggrieved by the adoption of the Local Plan may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

- a) the document is not within the appropriate power, and/or
- b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with

Any such application must be made no later than 6 weeks from the date on which the Local Plan was adopted.
