Notice is given that on 11th September 2019 Fylde Council adopted the Fylde Healthy Living Supplementary Planning Document.

Subject matter and area covered:

The Fylde Healthy Living Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) covers the whole of the Borough.

The Fylde Healthy Living SPD describes the issues associated with health and wellbeing in the Borough as well as suggesting ways to bring about improvements. The Healthy Living SPD also acknowledges the potential of Whyndyke Garden Village Healthy New Town in providing an exemplar development in terms of health and wellbeing provision.

Process Followed

On 14th November 2018 Planning Committee approved the SPD Scoping document for consultation.

On 27th February 2019 Planning Committee approved the Draft SPD for screening opinions and consultation.

On 11th September 2019 Planning Committee adopted the SPD for Development Management Purposes.

Challenge:

Any person who is aggrieved by the adoption of the Healthy Living Supplementary Planning Document may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:

- a) the document is not within the appropriate power, and/or
- b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with

Any such application must be made no later than 6 weeks from the date on which the Supplementary Planning Document was adopted, that is by 5.00pm on 24th October 2019.
