

**FYLDE BOROUGH COUNCIL**

**(LYTHAM ST ANNES REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY PROCESSION)**

**(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2021**

The Council of the Borough of Fylde in exercise of its powers under section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, as extended by Section 15 of the County of Lancashire Act 1984, hereby orders as follows:

On the date shown and during the times set out in the attached Schedule ('the Schedule'), no person (other than with the express permission of or on the special direction of a police constable) shall cause or permit a vehicle of any kind (other than a vehicle forming part of or otherwise used in connection with any event) to enter or proceed on the lengths of highways referred to in the Schedule. Access will be granted to emergency vehicles where and when necessary and pedestrian access will be maintained to properties at all times.

Please note that the closures are for the purposes of facilitating the Remembrance Sunday procession and the roads will not necessarily be closed for their entire lengths or for the entire periods of time referred to in the Schedule.

This Order shall be known as the Fylde Borough Council (Lytham St Annes Remembrance Sunday Procession) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2021 and shall come into force on the days and at the times set out in the Schedule.

14 <sup>th</sup> November 2021	Dicconson Terrace, Henry Street (between Queen St and Dicconson Terrace), Queen Street (between Henry St and Hastings Place), Hastings Place (from junction of Queen Street) and Market Square.	10.15 am to 12.15 pm

The closures shall be on rolling basis as and when required during the period of times referred to above.
