FYLDE GREEN REFUSE SACK COLLECTION SERVICE

- The Fylde green refuse sacks should only be used for household waste that cannot be recycled
- Households are limited to two Fylde green refuse sacks per week
- To prevent spillages please remember to secure Fylde green refuse sacks by tying the tops and take care not to overload the sacks
- All non-recyclable waste must be placed inside Fylde green sacks for collection. Black sacks or other containers will not be collected



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- The Fylde GREEN refuse sacks are collected on a weekly basis and replacement sacks will be left on collection day. The BLUE and BROWN recycling bins are collected fortnightly
- Please place the relevant containers at your designated collection point by 7:00am on your scheduled collection day
- Please place all items loose in the BLUE and BROWN recycling bins. Do not place any recyclable items in plastic bags
- Please remember recycling bins that contain the wrong items will not be collected
