The premises are modern industrial units set out of 2 stories, currently, both units 14 and 15 are empty shells but the intention will be to arrange them as set out in the plan.

Most of the accommodation will be used as storage for the successful online auction business which is well established.

A small retail area will be laid out on the 1st floor of unit 15 but the applicant is seeking to licence all areas to ensure as much business flexibility as possible.

Any customers attending the premises will do so on a prearranged appointment basis only. The business has been in operation since the mid-90s and had a liquor licence under the justices system and then applied for a new licence following the transition to the Licensing Act 2003.

They have operated from Charnley Road in Blackpool and currently hold a premises licence with Blackpool Council PL 1585.

This is a relocation and no changes to the current business model are intended.

The business has an excellent track record and has traded for many years without any concerns ever being raised by the Responsible Authorities

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

1. Admittance to the premises shall be by intercom with CCTV, or by appointment.

2 The licence holder shall participate in the promotion of the street drinking ban.

3. Deliveries to the premises shall be between the hours of 08.00 - 20.00 only.

4. No discount beers or alcopops shall be sold on the premises.

5.. In relation to internet sales of alcohol, the following steps will be taken:

1. The purchaser will be required to state (by means of a tick box) that they are over 18.

2. Only methods of payment available to over 18s (i.e. credit cards) will be accepted without obtaining further proof of identity and age.

3. Deliveries will only be left with persons over the age of 18.

4. The website will state prominently that deliveries will only be left with persons over the age of 18.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

A CCTV system shall be maintained and operated at the premises with cameras positioned both internally and externally.

Recorded CCTV images will be maintained and stored for a period of twenty-eight days and shall be produced to the Police or Licensing Authority upon request.

CCTV will be in operation at any time a person is in the premises. Where CCTV is recorded onto a hard drive system, any DVDs subsequently produced will be in a format so it can be played back on a standard PC or DVD player.

• The system will display on any recording the correct time and date of the recording.

- The system will make recordings during all hours the premises are open to the public.
- The system will, as a minimum, record images of the head and shoulders of all persons entering the premises.
- A staff member who is conversant with the operation of the CCTV will be able to attend the premises within an hour upon request by Police or responsible authority.

A Challenge 25 proof of age policy shall be implemented and adhered to. Any person who looks or appears to be under the age of 25 shall be asked to provide identification that they are over the age of 18. The following are the only forms of identification acceptable:

· A recognised proof of age scheme accredited under the British Retail Consortiums Proof of Age Standards Scheme (PASS).

- · Photo driving licence.
- · Passport.

 \cdot Official ID card issued by HM Forces or European Union bearing a photograph and date of birth of the holder.

If no suitable identification is provided the sale of alcohol to them will be refused. Suitable signage will be displayed to specify the Challenge 25 policy is in place.

All staff to have received suitable training in relation to the proof of age scheme. Refresher training on underage sales to be provided to all staff every six months. Records to evidence this will be made available to an authorised officer upon request.
