On first appointment, all staff employed at the premises shall receive training on the Licensing Act 2003. Said training shall be regularly refreshed at no less then annual intervals and must be recorded. The records must be accessible on the premises and made available for inspection upon request of a Police Officer or an authorised officer of the licensing authority or (in the case of online training) within 48 hours.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

An incident register shall be maintained at the premises and made available to the authorities on request.

A register of refusals of sales of alcohol shall be maintained at the premises. The register shall be made available for inspection by the Police or other responsible authority.

c) Public safety

A CCTV system shall be installed at the premises and be capable of the following: Will cover the entrance/exit and will be capable of providing an image regarded as identification standard;

The system shall display on any recording the correct time and date of the recording; The system shall be in operation during the hours the premises is open to the public; Digital recordings shall be held for a minimum of 31 days after the recording is made, and will be made available to the Police or any authorised person acting for a responsible authority for inspection on request.

 - Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
 - Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
