

# ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR, CRIME AND POLICING ACT 2014 (ABCPA 2014)

### **PUBLIC SPACES PROTECTION ORDER**

Made by: FYLDE BOROUGH COUNCIL (the Council)

### THE ORDER

This is a public spaces protection order made by the Council under section 59 of ABCPA 2014.

#### WHERE DOES THIS ORDER APPLY?

This order applies to any **ornamental water feature** in the district of the Council.

This means an area in the Promenade Gardens, or in a park, playing field or recreation ground, which comprises a paddling pool, boating pool, sand and water play area or an ornamental fountain, pond or waterfall.

#### WHEN DOES THIS ORDER APPLY?

This order comes into force on 1 October 2023 and applies up to and including 30 September 2026.

# 4. WHO DOES THIS ORDER APPLY TO?

This order applies to any person in charge of a dog.

## WHAT DOES THIS ORDER REQUIRE?

This order requires a person to **keep any dog in their charge out** of any area where this order applies.

### 6. ARE THERE ANY EXCEPTIONS?

The requirement in paragraph 5 above does not apply if:

The person has a reasonable excuse for not keeping the dog out of the area;

The person **is allowed** to have his dog in the area by the owner or occupier of the public place; or

The person has a disability (within the meaning of the Equality Act 2010) and the dog is their **guide dog** or assistance dog.

## 7. WHAT CAN HAPPEN IF I BREACH THIS ORDER?

You can be given a **fixed penalty** notice of £100. Or **you could be prosecuted** in the magistrates' court for a criminal offence and be fined up to £1,000.
