Girlguiding Kilgrimol Centre is at 67 Leach Lane, Lytham St Annes. The building is used for weekly Rainbow, Brownie and Guide meetings, volunteer trainings and meetings and is available for community use. The building was opened in 1984 but following flood damage over the years as well as age related deterioration our building is coming to the end of it's useful life and needs replacing. We have planning permission for an energy efficient building which will address the flood problems, with the footings already in place. We are actively fundraising for the building which will have activity spaces for Girlguiding and community groups plus facilities for Girlguiding holidays and sleepovers.
